The New Hampshire Racing and Charitable Gaming Commission, in compliance with the requirements of RSA 20:7, respectfully submits the following report of activities for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2011.

Charitable Gaming in New Hampshire continues to evolve. Maximum bet amounts for charitable gaming have not changed and remain at \$4 per individual wagering in Games of Chance, \$1 per bingo card (of three games), and .50 cents per Lucky-7 ticket. Currently the Commission regulates (11) games of chance facilities, (9) game operator employers, (10) commercial halls and approximately 500 charities associated with charitable gaming activities in addition to the oversight of (9) manufacturers and (5) distributors of Bingo-Lucky 7 equipment and paraphernalia.

Charitable gaming has proved to be a valuable fund raising resource for those charities that have chosen to participate in these events. In fiscal year 2011 (July 1, 2010 – June 30, 2011) charities have realized over \$13 million, to further their causes. This profit was driven by Lucky-7 ticket sales of \$60.6 million, Bingo sales of \$18.9 million and \$75.8 million in Game of Chance betting.

Our compliance and audit sections have conducted numerous audits, reviews and inspections to insure compliance with the statutes and promulgated rules. During the year, the agency conducted 17 audits and financial reviews and over 1,892 field inspections of licensees. The inspections resulted in the issuance of 82 warnings and 11 administrative hearings before the Commission. A total of 66 complaints were received and investigated. There were a total of 130 investigations initiated, of which 8 were referred to the Attorney General or local authorities for further review.

Total Pari-mutuel wagering amounted to \$87.6 million for the year all of which was from simulcast wagering. There has been no live racing since 2009, although live harness and live thoroughbred racing is still statutorily permitted. The legislature removed all funding from the Commission budget for the necessary employees to provide oversight and regulation of live racing. Consequently Rockingham Park elected not to offer live racing for the foreseeable future. The Lodge at Belmont surrendered its pari-mutuel license in December of 2010 and did not apply for a 2011 license, leaving only two pari-mutuel facilities operating, Seabrook Park (formally Seabrook Greyhound Park) and Rockingham Park. A total of 248 occupational licenses were issued at these race tracks.

In the 2011 legislative session, the legislature passed HB-348 and it was signed into law by the governor. This legislation enhanced previous year legislation by continuing to protect the charities and wagering public. Some of the major changes require primary game operators conducting games of chance to utilize video monitoring of all areas where money is handled, including table games, cash office, etc. Important language was included to now make it a felony for anyone to defraud charities of any monies legally due from charitable gaming. From a budgeting and accounting perspective, as part of the fiscal year 2012-2013 operating budget, the legislature moved all racing activities formerly accounted for in the general fund to the enterprise fund. All revenues from racing activities will be transferred to the Education Trust Fund.

The Commission will continue to seek the support of the executive branch and the legislature for changes in rules and statutes that will protect the public, improve the wagering experience and maximize revenue to the state and charities.

The members of the New Hampshire Racing and Charitable Gaming Commission wish to thank the Governor, members of the Executive Council, the General Court and all agency personnel with whom we have worked, for their continued support and cooperation.

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

## HORSE RACING PARI-MUTUEL TAX HISTORY

Pari-Mutuel wagering on horse racing became legal in New Hampshire in 1933. The tables below show the tax structure for horse racing in the state. The tax structure for harness from 1957 to 1982 was on a graduated scale based on handle. WPS indicates that the rates apply to win, place, and show pools only. Multi indicates all other pools, such as daily doubles, trifectas, and quiniellas. Breakage in 1933 was kept by the track. From 1939 to 1997 it was split evenly with the state. In 1997, the legislature changed the law to require that 50% of the state's share of breakage be returned to licensee for live racing purse enhancement.

## GREYHOUND RACING PARI-MUTUEL TAX HISTORY

Live Greyhound racing had been legal in New Hampshire from 1971 to 2010. The tax structure has been quite complicated at times, because of a system of tax credits and graduated tax rates based on handle. The table below shows the range of tax rates in place since 1971 as well as the tax credits. Breakage on greyhound racing has been split 50:50 between the track and the state. In 1997, the legislature changed the law to require that 50% of the state's share of breakage be returned to licensee for live racing purse enhancement.

## BINGO HISTORY

Bingo, formerly regulated as beano, has been legal in New Hampshire since 1949. In 1949, RSA 287 was enacted to regulate beano. In 1983, RSA 287 was repealed and re-enacted as RSA 287-E to regulate bingo. A tax of 5% was imposed in 1983 on winner-take-all games pursuant to RSA 287-E:8. The tax was raised to its current level of 7% in 1990. Pursuant to Chapter 257 of the Laws of NH 2004, authority for administration of bingo was transferred from the Lottery Commission and enforcement of bingo was transferred from the Department of Safety to the Racing and Charitable Gaming Commission on January 1, 2005.

Games of chance have been legal in New Hampshire since 1977. Pursuant to Chapter 311 of the Laws of NH 2006, authority for administration and enforcement of games of chance was expanded and transferred from the Attorney General's Office and the local chiefs of police to the Racing and Charitable Gaming Commission on July 19, 2006.

## LUCKY 7 HISTORY

Lucky 7 has been legal in New Hampshire since 1949. In 1949, RSA 287 was enacted to regulate lucky 7. In 1983, RSA 287 was repealed and re-enacted as RSA 287-E to regulate lucky 7. A fee of \$15 per deal of pull tab tickets and \$6 per deal of bag tickets was enacted in 1990 under RSA 287-E:22, I. Pursuant to Chapter 257 of the Laws of NH 2004, authority for administration of lucky 7 was transferred from the Lottery Commission and enforcement of lucky 7 was transferred from the Department of Safety to the Racing and Charitable Gaming Commission on January 1, 2005.
