### Game Procedures – Bad Beat Jackpot with Mini Qualifier

#### Texas Hold'em – Cash Games

The cash game bad beat jackpot is a prize that is paid out when two or more individuals are involved in a hand where at showdown for the main jackpot, quad deuces or better are beaten by a higher ranking hand, or the mini jackpot jacks full of twos is beaten by a higher ranking hand. When this occurs, the total dollar amount posted that day as the bad beat jackpot or mini bad beat jackpot amount is split amongst all qualifying Texas Hold'Em cash game participants in the cash game area where the bad beat hand occurred. The payout / split of the bad beat jackpot and all other rules governing it are specified within the points of this document.

1. The bad beat shall apply to the game of Texas Hold'Em only. "Main Bad Beat" means a hand of quad deuces or better is beaten by a higher ranking hand (example four deuces losing to four nines). "Mini Bad Beat" means a hand of Jacks full of deuces or better is beaten by a higher ranking hand (example jacks full of deuces losing to kings full of deuces).
2. In order for a hand to be eligible to qualify for a bad beat, the pot must meet a minimum of \$20.
3. A minimum of four players must be seated and dealt in at the beginning of the hand in order to qualify for either bad beat. Only players that have registered with The River Casino's players club will be eligible for ANY bad beat payout. Pots won by all players seated at a Texas Hold'Em cash game (eligible or not to receive a bad beat payout) will fund the bad beat jackpot. There are no exceptions.
4. To qualify for the main bad beat jackpot, a player must have four deuces or better beaten. If the winning or losing player has made a four of a kind, that player must have a pocket pair to qualify (example if a player has four eights, he or she must have a pocket pair of eights with two eights on the board).
5. To qualify for the mini bad beat jackpot, a player must have a full house with jacks full of deuces or better beaten. If the winning or losing player has made either a full house or four of a kind, that player must have a pocket pair to qualify.
6. Both the winning and losing hands for either the bad beat jackpot or the mini bad beat jackpot must use both of their hole cards to create the highest possible hand. If either the main bad beat jackpot or the mini bad beat jackpot are hit, 100% of displayed bad beat jackpot amount will be paid out as per rule #13.
7. A \$1 maximum amount will be removed from each pot according to rule #2. If it is a rake game, the \$20 or more includes the rake.
8. In order for a hand to be eligible for either bad beat jackpot, the pot must meet the minimum requirement for that game limit. The hand must go to a showdown (played to the end, where all cards have been dealt and players have completed betting and show their cards to determine the winner) in order for the jackpot to be awarded.
9. On a daily basis, for each \$1 collected, 63% will be added to the bad beat jackpot, 7% will be held in a bad beat reserve bank to replenish the bad beat jackpot when hit, 24% will be added to the mini bad beat jackpot, and 6% will be held in a mini bad beat reserve bank to replenish the mini bad beat jackpot when hit. These banks will be treated as the players' property and held in a separate checking account. The size of the bad beat jackpot, mini bad beat jackpot and both

reserve banks will be posted daily. No more or less than 100% of the bad beat jackpot monies deposited will be allocated for all current and future bad beat jackpots.

10. If a hand finishes with three qualifying hands, the lowest hand will only receive a player's share of the jackpot. Example four eights, four queens and a queen high straight flush are dealt in the same hand. The bad beat hand will be the four queens and the winning hand will be the queen high straight flush.
11. Players must play their hands independently. Any discussion of the prize during the playing of the hand may void the qualification for the bad beat jackpot. If any player, whether directly or indirectly involved in the hand, passes information or instructs another on how to act or reveals his or her hand to other players, the bad beat jackpot will be disqualified.
12. Management reserves the right to verify eligibility of all qualifying hands. There will be no recourse if the cards are mucked before surveillance was able to verify the hands and the community cards
13. Poker management will not be permitted to reconstruct the hands in any way. In order to collect any River Casino bad beat jackpot payout, proper identification will be required.
14. Payouts of the main bad beat jackpot are listed below. These payouts will be posted. Any and all changes to these percentages will be effective at the start of the new effective date.
  - a. 40% of the bad beat jackpot will be awarded to the bad beat hand (losing hand)
  - b. 20% of the bad beat jackpot will be awarded to the winner of the hand
  - c. 40% of the bad beat jackpot will be awarded equally among the balance of the seated players with chips in valid Texas Hold'Em cash games in the cash game area
15. Payouts of the mini bad beat jackpot are listed below. These payouts will be posted. Any and all changes to these percentages will be effective at the start of the new effective date.
  - a. 70% of the mini bad beat jackpot will be awarded to the bad beat hand (losing hand)
  - b. 30% of the mini bad beat jackpot will be awarded to the winner of the hand
16. A player who revokes his or her chips from the game prior to a showdown on a hand where a bad beat is won forfeits his or her right to any prize money.
17. A player who walks away from the game, but leaves his or her chips on the table AND he or she was in the hand at the beginning will retain rights to his or her share of the bad beat jackpot if a bad beat hand occurs.
18. Winners will be solely responsible for all taxes. Each winner will be required to provide a current valid ID to collect any winnings. Prizes are non-transferable. US citizens will be issued a W2G on winnings of \$600 or more. Players from foreign countries will be issued a 1042-S and they will generally be subject to a US income tax withholding of 30% regardless of the amount of the payout. Any player unable to provide a valid Social Security Number will be subject to a 30% withholding.
19. Prizes won are final. No substitution or transfer of prizes permitted.
20. In the rare occurrence of a bad beat jackpot being hit on more than one game at the same time surveillance will be contacted to determine the actual winner, verify whether the high or low jackpot was hit, and then the jackpot will be distributed on each game according to the percentages set forth in rule #10.
21. Decisions of the poker room supervisor are final and without recourse.
22. By participating in The River Casino bad beat jackpot, winners consent to the use of their names and photographs for promotional purposes without additional compensation.

23. In the event that (1) The River Casino decides to halt the cash bad beat jackpot any and all monies held by The River Casino for the cash bad beat jackpot will be awarded via a drawing. All players contributing funds to the current cash bad beat jackpot from the next day of the last paid cash bad beat jackpot will be given one entry to the drawing. This will be determined via a player registration in all cash games through The River Casino Player's Card. All players qualifying for an entry into the drawing will be posted. The date and time of the drawing will be posted. The winner must be present at the time of the drawing to claim their prize. Their name will be drawn every (5) minutes until a winner claims the reward. In the event the River Casino moves its location the jackpots will be continued at the new location from where they left off.
