•Blackjack Bonus

Game Objective:

There are 3 wagers to Blackjack Bonus. You must play conventional Blackjack in order to bet on the other two Bonus wagers. The objective of conventional Blackjack is to achieve a total greater than the dealer, without going over 21. One of the other two wagers is the Three Card Bonus Wager in which the objective is to match a three card poker hand (players two cards with the dealer's up card) with it's Pay Table. The final wager is the Bonus 7's in which the objective is again to match cards with 7's with it's Pay Table.

Game Rules:

Conventional Blackjack Rules (Primary Wager)

- Split any pair
- Double after split allowed
- Double on any two cards
- Blackjacks pay 3 to 2 or 2 to 1 as posted
- Dealer hits a soft 17

Equipment Used:

Standard Casino Blackjack Gaming Table
Blackjack Bonus Layout
Six decks of 52 cards
Discard rack
2 Cut Cards
Gaming chips of denominations of \$.50, \$1, \$2, \$3, \$4

Method of Play:

Prior to the first card being dealt for each round of play, each player may make a 3 Card Poker Bonus wager and/or a Bonus 7's wager by placing gaming chips in the designated betting area on the Bonus Blackjack layout. A player shall be permitted to make these wagers only if he or she has first placed a blackjack wager. You win on the Bonus bets regardless if you win or loose on your Blackjack hand.

The 3 Card Poker Bonus bet will be a three card poker hand that will consist of the players first to cards and the Dealers up card. Immediately after the second card is dealt to each player and the dealer, and prior to any additional cards being dealt to any player the Poker Bonus will be collected or paid in

accordance to the Poker Bonus pay table.

The Bonus 7's bet will consist of a player's first card, first two cards, or first three cards being a 7. Odds pay better for the 7's being of the same suit. The payoffs aren't cumulative, for example if you get three sevens you don't get paid for one seven then two sevens as well. If the dealer gets a blackjack the player still gets paid for at least two sevens, a third card will not be drawn.

Types of Wagers:

Conventional (Primary) Blackjack Wager
Three Card Bonus Wager
Bonus 7's Wager

Wager Amounts:

Conventional (Primary) Blackjack Wager : \$2 minimum and \$4 maximum
Three Card Bonus Wager : \$1 minimum and \$4 maximum
Bonus 7's Wager : \$1 minimum and \$4 maximum

Payout Table:

Insurance Bets pay 2-1
All Standard Blackjack (primary wager) bets pay 3 to 2.

Poker Bonus

The following are payoffs for the 3Card Poker bet:

<u>Hand</u>	<u>Pays</u>
Suited three of a kind	100-1
Straight flush	30-1
Three of a Kind	20-1
Straight	7-1
Flush	4-1

Bonus 7's

The following are payoffs for the Bonus 7's bet:

<u>Hand</u>	<u>Pays</u>
First card a seven	3-1
First two cards unsuited sevens	50-1
First two card suited sevens	100-1
First three cards unsuited sevens	250-1
First three cards suited sevens	500-1

House Rules:

▲ Before all tournaments, the Brush will announce the cost of the buy-in and any applicable re-buys/add-ons. Specific amounts are attached to the game schedule.

▲ Hourly tournaments interrupted by power failure or any other uncontrollable factor are automatically void unless only three players remain, in which case a determination of final position will be made based on each player's chip count.

- Multi-table tournaments will complete the hand if readable and agreeable to all players, otherwise the hand is dead. Remaining prize money will be evenly divided among all remaining players, regardless of chip count.

- Cash games and games of chance will complete the hand if readable and agreeable to all players. Otherwise, the hand is dead.

▲ Games of chance offer no refund. Chips purchased or won may be redeemed for face value and must be redeemed on the same day.

▲ Refunds will be given in tournaments prior to dealing the first card. In close call situations, and in fairness to other players, no refunds will be issued.

▲ As per RSA 287-D: 2-b, XI; each player may spend up to the amount allowed by law per tournament, except (RSA 287-D: 2-b, XII) the charity may offer one tournament per licensed event in which each player may spend up to the amount allowed by law..

▲ Chips remain the property of Casablanca Casino LLC. and must be redeemed on the date of issue.

▲ The maximum bet on all games of chance is the amount allowed by RSA 287-D. The maximum bet on live (cash) poker games is the amount allowed by RSA 287-D. The number of raises permitted shall be determined by Casablanca Casino, LLC and posted in public view. There is no bet limit on tournament games where chips have no monetary value.

▲ All Games of Chance and Tournament Gaming areas are Non-Smoking. Smoking is permitted outside.

▲ A portion of the proceeds as required by RSA 287-D will be used to support the charity that sponsors the events of the day.
