

IX. NH HOLD-EM

Players must ante to receive two down cards. There are three rounds of betting after receiving their first two cards, the flop, turn, and the river. Players must bet on each round to continue playing the hand. Any time they choose not to continue betting, they forfeit all bets placed on that hand. A player must bet 1 bet equal to their ante to continue to the next round, but they may bet two or three bets to the next round if they want to. Once every player has folded or bet, the dealer burns and turns up one community card "the turn". Once every player has bet or folded the turn, the dealer burns and turns a final community card "the river". Each player is then paid or loses based on the following pay table:

Royal Flush	100 to 1
Straight flush	50 to 1
Four of a Kind	25 to 1
Full House	9 to 1
Flush	6 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Trips	3 to 1
Two Pair	2 to 1
Pair of Jacks or better	1 to 1
Pair of 6's to 10's	Push

\$1000 max payout per hand

Max \$4 bet per spot

Pair Plus Bonus Wager

An additional bonus wager is offered to each player called a "Pair Plus Bonus". Player may wager in the range of \$1 to \$4.

All winning bonus wagers shall be paid in accordance with the payout schedule below.

A bonus wager shall have no bearing on any other wager made by a player at the game of NH Hold Em Poker.

Straight Flush	30 to 1
Three of a Kind	25 to 1
Straight	5 to 1
Flush	3 to 1
Pair	1 to 1

This bet will be paid or taken by the dealer at the duration of the hand when all cards have been exposed. A player may choose to fold their two card NH Hold Em hand but their Pair Plus Bonus Wager will remain live in the game. The Pair Plus Bonus Wager is based on the dealer's three up cards (Flop, Turn, and River).
