IX. NH HOLD-EM

Players must ante to receive two down cards. There are three rounds of betting after receiving their first two cards, the flop, turn, and the river. Players must bet on each round to continue playing the hand. Any time they choose not to continue betting, they forfeit all bets placed on that hand. A player must bet 1 bet equal to their ante to continue to the next round, but they may bet two or three bets to the next round if they want to. Once every player has folded or bet, the dealer burns and turns up one community card "the flop". Once every player has bet or folded the flop the dealer burns and turns up one community card "the turn". Once every player has bet or folded the turn, the dealer burns and turns a final community card "the river". Each player is then paid or loses based on the following paytable.

Royal Flush	250 to 1
Straight Flush	80 to 1
Four of a Kind	30 to 1
Full House	8 to 1
Flush	6 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Trips	3 to 1
Two Pair	2 to 1
Pair of Jacks or better	1 to 1
Pair of 7's to 10's	Push
