Three Card Poker Table Game with Pair Plus Bets

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Object of the game:

The players will play their three cards against the dealer's three cards in an effort to get a better hand than the dealer. They will also have the option to bet on their three cards containing a pair or better.

Rules of the game:

The dealer will switch between two decks each hand, washing and shuffling the deck before use.

The game will be dealt from left to right, each player receiving one card at a time, until all players at the table and the dealer have three facedown cards. These hole cards must be kept private by the player who receives them.

Once a player places their last bet, the cards must be placed in front of their chips. From this point on, only the dealer may touch the cards.

Any three of a kind or straight flush will be called out by the dealer and acknowledged by the floor manager.

Equipment to be used:

The dealer will have two standard 52 card decks, a rack of chips available for players to purchase, and a tray of chips that will be used for payouts.

Three Card Poker Method of Play

Players make a two or four dollar ante wager. The play bet, which is to be explained shortly, must match this ante bet.

Players will also choose to place a two or four dollar pair plus bet. This can be different from their ante bet.

A player can choose to play only pair plus or ante. They are not obligated to play both.

The dealer gives each player and themselves three cards face down. Players may, and should, examine their cards. Each person's hole cards must remain concealed from other players at the table.

Players who have played only pair plus must now put their cards in front of their bet. They can now only be touched by the dealer.

Players who have played ante must now match their ante bet on the "play" spot. After placing this play bet, players will put their cards in front of their bets. They can now only be touched by the dealer.

The dealer reveals their hand, and one player at a time reveals the player's cards.

The dealer pays out or collects bets based on the strength of theirs and the player's hands. Please refer to the payouts section for more details.

All wagers paid according to the pay table included in the payouts section.

Types of Wagers for the game/Wager amount for the game:

Players make a two or four dollar ante wager. The play bet must match this ante bet. Players will also choose to place a two or four dollar pair plus bet. This can be different from their ante bet.

Payout and Payout odds:

Ante and Play

After all bets are placed, the dealer reveals their hand. If the dealer has queen high or better they qualify.

If the dealer does not qualify, each player gets paid even money on their ante bet, and their play bet is a push.

If the dealer does qualify, and the player's hand is better, following the payout chart below, the player is paid even money on their ante and play bets.

If the dealer qualifies and their hand is better than the player's, the player loses their ante and play bets.

In the case of a qualifying hand and a tie, the bets are both a push.

Additionally, if a player receives one of the three best hands, Straight, Three of a kind and a Straight Flush, the player will receive an additional bonus payout of 1:1, 4:1 and 5:1 respectively on their ante bet.

Pair Plus

Pair plus is paid independently of the dealer's cards.

Straight	6:1
Three of a Kind	30:1

Straight Flush

40:1
