

Points Tournament Procedure:

Objective:

- Award Players for playing in tournaments at Keene Poker Room.
- Stimulate tournament turn out.

Method of Play:

- This will be a Texas Holdem Tournament, following all procedures already in place for Texas Holdem tournament play.
- Prize pool will be distributed to players based on house rules.

Rules of Tournament:

- This tournament will be held Bi-Annually (second Saturday in January and July)
- All other scheduled tournaments will still be played on this day. (schedule will remain as all other normal Saturdays)
- Point standings will be updated each week and posted in poker room, on our Facebook group page and via e-mail to those who provide a valid e-mail address (optional).
- Players will be awarded points based on their order of finish in all tournaments.
- This is a free tournament to the players who qualify to participate.
- Prize pool will be constructed by donation from prize pool of tournaments, a \$1.00/person entered will be held out in qualified tournaments, except for the \$5.00 Re-buy, \$100, \$150, \$250 deep stack tournaments which will be \$2.00/person.
- Top 27 (+ ties for the 27<sup>th</sup> spot) players in player points will qualify.
- Tournament will start with 9 players per table, final table will be 10 players.
- Each player will start tournament with 10,000 chips, players will be awarded bonus chips based on their order in points.
- A 10% administration fee will be held out of the prize pool (cover cost of tournament, Charity etc.).
- Points will be awarded to players based on their order of finish in qualified tournaments. (only players who cash receive points for that tournament).
- Only the posted prize pool qualifies for points. (Posted prize pool by Manager is the top 5 players and table chooses to pay top 6, 6<sup>th</sup> place does NOT qualify for points.
- In the event that two players get knocked out of the tournament on the same hand and they have equal chip count then an average of the two spots they finished will be awarded. (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> is 40 points 6<sup>th</sup> is 30 points both players will receive 35 points.).
- In the event of an even chop of the prize pool (or portion of prize pool) a chip count will be taken to determine order of point distribution.
- Players will be positioned at poker table by random draw by Tournament Director.
- All chip stacks will be placed on table prior to tournament (chips will be blinded off if player is not at table at start of tournament.).
- Players will have 4 blind levels to claim their chips, at the end of 4<sup>th</sup> blind level players who haven't claimed their chip stack it will be removed from the table of play.
- In the event tournament needs to be postponed due to room closure (weather, power failure etc.) tournament will be rescheduled for the first Saturday available.
