Table Stakes Texas Hold 'em

Object of the game:

Players will compete to accumulate chips from one another. Each chip will represent a cash value of \$1, \$5 or \$25.

Rules of the Game:

Blinds will be \$1-\$2 or \$2-\$4. Buy in limits may not be altered.

Forced bets (blinds or antes) will not exceed \$4.

A player may purchase no more than \$150 in chips per hands.

Minimum table buy-in will be \$60.

No buy-ins will be allowed that brings a player's chip stack over \$450.

Table rake will be 10% of each pot up to \$5, plus \$1 per hand towards the live action bad beat.

Table stakes tables will have a separate bad beat from tournaments. This bad beat will follow all previously sanctioned rules and procedures for our other two bad beat jackpots.

Cash on the table will not count as active money for the game. This is to ensure compliance with buy in limits.

Players will not be forced to reveal their hands at a showdown, but must still reveal their full hand to win the pot.

Players must cash out all their chips if they are leaving the game. They cannot cash out a portion of their chips and continue playing. If a player wishes to reenter the table, they must wait a full button rotation.

Players can choose to move between seats as they open. A player moving further away from the big blind must post the big blind in order to receive a hand. Players on a waiting list to sit at the table will have the option to sit wherever an open seat is available after players already seated at the table have had the option to move to the new seat.

Equipment to be used:

Each table will have a cash chip rack, a deck of cards, a dealer button, an all-in button, and two seat change buttons.

Table Stakes Hold 'em methods of play:

Table Stakes Hold 'em methods of play are identical to the previously approved Texas Hold 'em methods of play in Game of Chance 12-040.

Types of Wager/wager amount for the game:

Table Stakes poker will have a minimum table buy in of \$60, and a maximum buy in of \$150 per hand. No player will

be allowed to buy additional chips if it puts their stack above \$450 in chips. Chips can only be purchased between hands.

Blinds will be \$1-\$2 by default, but can be altered upon unanimous approval by the table. Players cannot alter the buy in minimums or maximums, and forced bets cannot be higher than \$4.

Payouts and payout odds:

Players are free to cash out their chips at their convenience. Chips must be cashed out in full, and only while a player is not involved in a hand.

House Rules applicable to all games:

No swearing at or berating other players or staff.

Protect your hand at all times.

English only, even if speaking to someone off the table.

Verbal declarations of action are binding.
